By letter dated July 22, 2011, KOB-TV, LLC, which had been the licensee of analog station KOBG-TV, Silver City, New Mexico,¹ notified the Commission that it was surrendering any rights and authority it possesses to a license for KOBG-TV. In view of the foregoing, the above-referenced applications for an extension of KOB's STA to operate a digital facility on channel 12 with an ERP of 13 watts and for a digital construction permit ARE HEREBY DISMISSED and the station's call sign IS DELETED.
