Dear Licensee:

This is with respect to the letter dated March 25, 2011, from the Video Services Division to Aracelis Ortiz Corporation, the licensee of Class A television station KCOS-LP, Phoenix, AZ, regarding your apparent failure to make the required filing of quarterly FCC Form 398 (Children's Television Programming Report) for the station. The Division's March 25 letter indicated that Aracelis Ortiz Corporation failed to make the required Form 398 electronic filings for the fourth quarter in 2008 and all four quarters in 2009 and 2010, and required you to provide information, supported by the declaration of a person with personal knowledge, identifying the quarters in 2008, 2009 and 2010 for which reports were prepared and placed in the station's public file and the location of the public file. The letter further required that this information be filed within 30 days and stated that failure to provide the requested information or to notify the staff that you were electing to let station KCOS-LP revert to low power television status would result in the institution of a forfeiture proceeding and/or loss of Class A television status.

As of today, the Commission has not received a response to the Division's March 25, 2011 letter. Failure to provide the information required in the March 25 letter within 30 days from the date of this letter will result in a change of the station's status from Class A television to low power television status.
