Dear Mr. Moline:

This is in reference to the above-captioned Auction No. 84 application filed by Mainstreet for a new AM station at Walsenburg, Colorado.

A preliminary study of the application reveals that an environmental showing of compliance with the requirements of the NHPA (Environmental Protection Act) is not provided.<sup>1</sup>

In addition, the proposed tower is close to an airport and must be registered. Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 17.4(a)(1), as modified by the *Report and Order* in WT Docket 95-5, 61 FR 4359 (1996), any proposed antenna structure or existing antenna structure must be registered with the Commission. Our records indicate that the proposed antenna structures have not been registered. Thus, we are unable to continue processing the application. Accordingly, the antenna structures must be registered by filing an FCC Form 854, Application for Antenna Structure Registration, with the Commission's Support Services Branch of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau's Customer Services Division in Gettysburg, Pennsylvania. Upon registration, written notification (including the registration number) must be submitted to the Audio Division (AD). If the antenna structure cannot be successfully registered within sixty days of the date of this letter, Mainstreet must notify the Audio Division in writing.

Further action on the subject application will be withheld for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of this letter to provide Mainstreet an opportunity to respond. Failure to respond within this time period will result in the dismissal of the application pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3568.
