Request For Special Temporary Authority To Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Dewees:

This letter concerns the request, filed on January 7, 2011, on behalf of KSBJ Educational Foundation ("KSBJ"), for Special Temporary Authority to permit FM Translator Station K259AB to remain silent.

KSBJ's request states that K259AB went silent on December 10, 2010, due to interference problems. KSBJ's request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

KSBJ's request will be granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station K259AB to remain silent not to exceed December 10, 2011. Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for K259AB will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m., December 11, 2011. See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. Section 312(g).

renewal of broadcast license. Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. See 47 C.F.R. Sections 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
