Request for Increased Digital Power Hybrid IBOC Digital Operation

Dear Mr. Downey:

This is in reference to the request filed August 26, 2011, on behalf of the University of Utah ("University"). University requests authority to operate Station KUHU(FM) with increased digital effective radiated power ("ERP") of -10 dBc¹, pursuant to the Media Bureau's *Order* adopted January 27, 2010, in MM Docket No. 99-325 ("*Order*").

Our review indicates that the notification requirements of the *Order* have been satisfied, and that the proposed operation complies with the contour nonoverlap and other technical requirements of the *Order*.

Accordingly, the request IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KUHU(FM) may operate with increased digital ERP and transmitter power output ("TPO"), as follows:

Analog ERP: 0.280 kW (Vertical)
Digital ERP: 0.028 kW (Vertical)

Analog TPO: 0.110 kW
Digital TPO: 0.011 kW
Combined TPO: 0.121 kW

University must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines; *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. It may be necessary to reduce the power of the digital signal or cease hybrid operation if interference

complaints are received. This authority may be modified or cancelled by the Commission without notice or right to hearing. This authority attaches to, and runs concurrently with, the main station license. University must post a copy of this authority with the station license.
