Authority To Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Gray:

This letter concerns the request, filed on January 18, 2011, on behalf Malvern Entertainment Corporation ("MEC"), for Special Temporary Authority to permit FM Station KFXV to remain silent.

MEC's request states that KFXV(FM) went silent on January 1, 2011, due to the loss of its tower site. MEC's request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

MEC's request will be granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit FM Station KFXV to remain silent for a period not to exceed January 1, 2012. **Notwithstanding the grant of this special temporary authority, the broadcast license for KFXV(FM) will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m. on January 2, 2012.**<sup>1</sup> See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. Section 312(g).


The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. See 47 C.F.R. Sections 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
