By letter dated August 6, 2010, the staff dismissed the above-referenced digital flash-cut application because the Government of Mexico objected to the proposed facility because it does not comply with the distance required for protection of channel 41 at Sonoita, Sonora. Una Vez Mas Phoenix License, LLC filed a timely petition for reconsideration submitting an engineering statement demonstrating that no interference would result from the operation of its proposed facility to a full-power facility operating on channel 41 at Sonoita.

In view of the foregoing, the petition for reconsideration IS GRANTED and the application IS REINSTATED for further coordination with the Government of Mexico.
