Dear Applicant:

By letter dated March 16, 2011, the staff dismissed the above-referenced application for a new digital low power television station on channel 24 at Logan, Utah because MCUSA, Inc. had failed to respond to a deficiency letter requiring it to amend its application to resolve predicted interference to stations K23GR-D and K25HG-D Preston, Utah. MCUSA filed a timely petition for reconsideration, submitting a letter dated March 21, 2011 from the licensee of the Preston stations to the Commission, saying that it has no objection to grant of MCUSA's application "provided that the construction permit is issued with the requirement to use a mask filter." MCUSA further states that if reconsideration is granted, it will amend its application to specify a channel emission mask.

In view of the foregoing, the petition for reconsideration IS GRANTED and the application IS REINSTATED for further processing. MCUSA, Inc. is directed to amend its application within 30 days from the date of this letter.
