Request for Extension of Special Temporary Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Youngers:

This letter concerns the request you filed on July 11, 2011, on behalf of Youngers Colorado Broadcasting, Inc. ("YCB"), for extension of Special Temporary Authority to permit FM Translator Station K252EA to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that YCB stated that Station K252EA went silent on November 30, 2010, due to the relocation of its transmitter site. The previous STA was granted on January 12, 2011, and expired on July 11, 2011. YCB requests extension of its STA because it has had difficulties relocating its transmitter site. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

YCB's request will be granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station K252EA to remain silent not to exceed November 17, 2011. Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station K252EA will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m., November 18, 2011. See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 312(g).

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. See 47 C.F.R. §§ 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
