Request for Special Temporary
Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Kestler:

This letter concerns the request you filed on March 22, 2011, on behalf of Calvary Chapel of Twin Falls, Inc. ("CCTF"), for Special Temporary Authority to permit FM Translator Station W201BJ to remain silent.


CCTF's request states that Station W201BJ went silent on March 22, 2011, due to interference to a full power station. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

CCTF's request will be granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station W201BJ to remain silent until March 22, 2012. **Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station W201BJ will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m., March 23, 2012.**¹ See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 312(g).

¹ In addition to filing electronically with the Commission on the date operations resume, notification of resumption of broadcast operations must be emailed to Denise.Williams@FCC.gov.

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. *See* 47 C.F.R. §§ 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
