Request for Special Temporary Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Andres:

This letter concerns your request filed on March 16, 2011, on behalf of Golden Age Communications ("GAC") for Special Temporary Authority to permit FM Low Power Radio Station WQDD-LP to remain silent.

GAC's request states that WQDD-LP went silent on March 16, 2011, due to flood damage to its transmitter building. GAC's request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

GAC's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station WQDD-LP to remain silent until March 16, 2012. Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station WQDD-LP will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m., March 17, 2012. See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. §312(g).

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for

renewal of broadcast license. Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. See 47 C.F.R. Sections 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
