Dear Applicant:

This letter refers to the above-captioned minor change to a licensed facility application to relocate the facilities of WDXX(FM) and to increase the antenna height above average terrain.

The application indicates that proposed facility is not excluded from environmental processing as required by the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA). Broadsouth Communications, Inc. ("BCI") must provide either an environmental assessment (EA), or certify that operation of the proposed station will not have a significant environmental impact by giving an affirmative response to Item 17 in Section III-B of the instant application.¹

Further action on the subject application will be withheld for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of this letter to provide BCI an opportunity to submit the requested information. If BCI cannot demonstrate NEPA compliance within 30 days of the date of this letter, the Audio Division (AD) must be notified in writing, concerning the delay.² In the event that further delays occur, BCI must provide the Audio Division with written updates every 60 days thereafter.³

² If this cannot be accomplished within the initial 30 day period, the first response to this letter shall be filed in triplicate with the Secretary of the Commission and shall contain a specific narrative of the actions taken to accomplish this requirement.

³ Each 60 day update shall be filed in triplicate with the Secretary of the Commission and shall report specific actions taken since the previous report toward obtaining and environmental compliance.

Failure to respond within this time period or to provide the written updates will result in the dismissal of the application for failure to prosecute pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3568(a)(1).
