## In re: WCDE(FM), Elkins, WV Facility ID No. 4298 Silent since April 7, 2011

Request for Special Temporary Authority to Remain Silent

Dear President Smith:

This letter concerns the request you filed on May 5, 2011, on behalf of the Board of Trustees, Davis & Elkins College ("DEC"), for Special Temporary Authority to permit FM Radio Station WCDE to remain silent.

DEC's request states that Station WCDE(FM) went silent on April 7, 2011, due to a decrease in student staffing availability. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

DEC's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station WCDE(FM) to remain silent until April 7, 2012. Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station WCDE(FM) will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m., April 8, 2012.<sup>1</sup> See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 312(g).

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for

renewal of broadcast license. Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. *See* 47 C.F.R. §§ 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
