Dear Licensee:

This is with respect to station KCDR-LP, Cedar Rapids, Iowa. Section 312(g) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,<sup>1</sup> provides that:

If a broadcasting station fails to transmit broadcast signals for any consecutive 12-month period, then the station license granted for the operation of that broadcast station expires at the end of that period, notwithstanding any provision, term or condition of the license to the contrary . . .

Commission records indicate that KCDR-LP has been silent since November 15, 2010.<sup>2</sup> Accordingly, the license for KCDR-LP IS HEREBY CANCELLED and the call sign IS DELETED. In addition, the above-referenced STA request is HEREBY DISMISSED.
