Request for Special Temporary Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Alpert:

This letter concerns the request you filed on November 17, 2011, on behalf of Azteca Communications of Alabama, Inc. ("ACA"), for Special Temporary Authority to permit AM Radio Station WCOC to remain silent.

ACA's request states that Station WCOC(AM) went silent on August 12, 2011, for financial reasons. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.<sup>1</sup>

ACA's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station WCOC(AM) to remain silent not to exceed 180 days from the date of this letter. Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station WCOC(AM) will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m., August 13, 2012. See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 312(g).

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. Additionally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. *See* 47 C.F.R. §§ 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).

Finally, Section 73.1740(a)(4) of the Commission's Rules permits licensees to discontinue operations for good cause, and for a period not to exceed 30 days without further authority. See 47 C.F.R. §73.1740(a)(4). This rule requires that the licensee notify the Commission by letter "not later than the 10<sup>th</sup> day of limited or discontinued operations," and if operations are not able to commence by the 10<sup>th</sup> day, "informal written request shall be made to the FCC no later than the 30<sup>th</sup> day for such additional time as may be deemed necessary." ACA failed to submit a timely request for an STA to permit Station

WCOC(AM) to remain silent beyond September 12, 2011, and the action taken herein shall not be construed as authorizing the station to remain silent between September 12, 2011, and November 17, 2011.
