K-5 Communications, LLC Special Temporary Authorization

## Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed November 14, 2011, on behalf of K-5 Communications, LLC ("K-5"). K-5 requests further extension of the special temporary authorization (STA) originally granted on September 18, 1998, for operation of Station WRJE (formerly WAMS, WMHZ) with power reduced to 25 per cent of licensed power, employing a nondirectional antenna.<sup>1</sup>

In support of the request, K-5 states that its application for construction permit to relocate the station was dismissed, and that it has retained a new consulting engineer to correct the error and file a new application.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond
  the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve
  the problem.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> WRJE is licensed for operation on 1600 kHz with 5 kilowatts daytime and 1 kilowatt nighttime, employing different directional antenna patterns day and night (DA-2-U).

Our review indicates that the licensee has been prevented from restoring licensed operation due to causes beyond its control and has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WRJE may continue to operate at its licensed site with reduced power not to exceed 1.25 kilowatts daytime and 0.25 kilowatt nighttime, nondirectional. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. K-5 must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on July 17, 2012.
