In the Reply to Opposition to Petition to Dismiss and Deny you filed on behalf of Connecticut Public Broadcasting, Inc., you stated that your client would not object to a grant of the above-noted displacement application, provided that the following condition is added.

- “1. The maximum Effective Radiated Power (ERP) shall not exceed 1 kW in any horizontal or vertical direction regardless of any electrical or mechanical beam tilt that may be employed.
2. Documentation demonstrating compliance with the preceding special operating condition shall be submitted at the time of filing of FCC Form 302-CA.”
