On behalf of Jupiter Planet Radio, LLC ("JPR"), licensee of Station WJBW, Jupiter, Florida ("WJBW"), and pursuant to Section 73.1125(d)(1) of the Commission's rules, this is to provide notice that as of February 1, 2012, the main studio of WJBW will temporarily relocate to 2475 Mercer Ave - Suite 103, West Palm Beach, Florida 33401. I have been informed by my client that the new temporary main studio location is within 25 miles from the reference coordinates for Jupiter, Florida. <sup>1</sup>
