

On February 22, 1999, you filed the above referenced application for a construction permit to modify the facilities of KAYA(FM), Hubbard, Nebraska. The application requests a waiver of the Commission's main studio rule, 47 C.F.R. § 73.1125, to locate the KAYA(FM) main studio outside of the station's 3.16mV contour. However, on October 13, 1999, you requested the dismissal of the construction permit application stating that the location of the main studio for KAYA(FM) is in compliance with 47 C.F.R. § 73.1125.

Accordingly, the application (BPED-990222MF) to modify the facilities of KAYA(FM) IS HEREBY DISMISSED pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.356(a).
