Dear Applicant:

This refers to the above-captioned minor change application to modify operation to Channel 266L1.

On February 2, 2012, LUB filed a minor change application proposing to operate on Channel 266 and create a second-adjacent channel short-spacing to the construction permit BPH-20091016AEO for station KCLS(FM), Leeds, UT, facility ID No. 55461. Pursuant to the second adjacent channel waiver procedures adopted by the Commission in its Third Report and Order in *Creation of a Low Power Radio Service*,¹ Canyon Media Group, LLC, licensee of KCLS is required to provide its consent or state with particularity why the proposal should not be approved. As part of contingent application filings for stations KCLS and KPLD, Canyon Media Group LLC, stated that it has no objection to KOEZ-LP's proposed channel change.²

An engineering analysis has determined that there are no alternate, fully spaced, and rule compliant channels available to mitigate displacement of KOEZ-LP by license BLH-20101112AJY for station KPLD(FM), Kanab, UT. In evaluating whether the public interest would be served by grant of a waiver of Section 73.807, the Commission must balance the potential for new interference to the full service station against the potential loss of an LPFM station. Based on the 100 dBu interference signal strength calculation, the predicted interference area is not located near densely populated areas.

In accordance with the procedures adopted by the Commission in *Creation of a Low Power Radio Service*, this letter constitutes approval to operate under special temporary authority ("STA") with the following facilities:

Channel	266 (101.1 MHz)
Effective radiated power:	0.020 kilowatt
Antenna height:	
above ground:	28 meters
above mean sea level:	980 meters
Above average terrain:	67 meters

Application BPL-20120202AAA will be retained in pending status and the request for STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. STAs issued pursuant to these procedures will be subject to any action taken by the Commission in the *Second Further Notice*. The Commission will withhold final determination of the waiver request until action on the *Second Further Notice* proposals.

KOEZ-LP must notify the Commission when STA operation has commenced. KOEZ-LP must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **August 9, 2012**.
