Dear Ms. Strayer:

This is in response to the above-referenced application filed by Educational Media Foundation ("EMF) to modify the license of FM radio station KLVS, Grass Valley, California from commercial to noncommercial, educational. The application also requests a waiver of the Commission's main studio rule, Section 73.1125(a) to permit KLVS to operate as a satellite of commonly owned noncommercial, educational FM radio station KLVR, Santa Rosa, California.

On January 30, 1998, the Commission staff granted this application and authorized KLVS(FM) to operate as a satellite station of KLVR(FM), Santa Rosa, California. However, further analysis reveals that KLVS(FM) is not a licensed facility because the pending license application (BLH-970912KF) to cover its construction permit (BPH-851030MG) has not been granted.

Accordingly, the Commission action of January 30, 1998, granting application BMLED-971015KF and waiving 47 C.F.R. § 73.1125, IS HEREBY RESCINDED. We will treat application BMLED-971015KF as an amendment to the earlier filed license application, BLH-970912KF, and expect Educational Media Foundation to maintain a main studio for KLVS(FM) in accordance with Section 47 C.F.R. § 73.1125 until grant of the pending license application
