

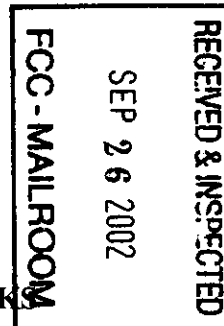

(Main Studio Rule)

Dear Mr. Vaughn:

Commission records indicate that on July 2, 1997, American Family Association ("AFA") was granted a waiver of the main studio rule, Section 73.1125, in order to operate KAKA(FM), Salina, Kansas as a satellite station of commonly owned noncommercial educational FM station, KBUZ(FM), Topeka, Kansas.

On August 8, 2002, you filed a request to modify the KAKA(FM) main studio waiver to specify noncommercial educational station, KCFN(FM), Wichita, Kansas as the originating station. In a September 20, 2002 supplement to this request, you state that the change in originating station is necessary because less interference to KAKA(FM)'s STL is received from Wichita than from Topeka. AFA's request IS GRANTED. However, AFA is reminded that the public inspection file for KAKA(FM) must now be maintained at the main studio of the new "parent" station, KCFN(FM), Wichita, Kansas and that the KAKA (FM) public inspection file must contain the quarterly issues and programs list for Salina, Kansas.
