We just discovered an error that we made in filing the license of channel 27 KHTV-LD (Facility 60026, BLDTL-20120217ABO). Because the gain of the antenna was much higher and the line loss was much, much lower than we originally anticipated we only needed 0.5 kw out of the transmitter instead of the 2.0 kw that was put on the CP (BDISDTL-20090821ADM). The horizontal plane pattern is not changed, nor is the ERP, nor is the coverage area. However, when we filed for the license we inadvertently did not inform the FCC that there was this discrepancy from the CP.

The license application was just filed last week but you granted it already so I cannot go in and formally amend it. Can you simply approve this or do we have to file a formal modification of the license?
