Illinois Bible seeks a waiver of 47 C.F.R. § 73.1125(a) (4) to operate the WRVY-FM facility as a satellite station of commonly owned station WCIC(FM), Pekin, Illinois.

In order to ensure that local issues in Henry will be met, Illinois Bible has agreed to undertake the following:

1. Illinois Bible will establish an advisory board comprised of local community leaders including the Henry service area. This board will provide regular input on programming.
2. Illinois Bible will conduct an informal ascertainment of area leaders on an on-going basis. Contacts will be made with leaders in the government, civic organizations, religious organizations, businesses, and other groups.
3. Illinois Bible plans to air, on a weekly basis, a one-half hour public affairs or news program dealing specifically with the needs in the Henry service area. The program could include interviews with area leaders.
4. Remote recording equipment on hand will allow Illinois Bible Institute to gather material for later airing on the planned public affairs/news program and for use in regularly scheduled news programs.
5. Illinois Bible will monitor news in the area through a subscription to the local/county newspaper and via the United Press International wire. As finances permit, a news bureau in Henry will be established.
