Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed January 13, 2012, on behalf of Weeks Broadcasting, Inc. ("WBI"). WBI requests extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on April 22, 2011, to operate Station KXCS with temporary facilities.¹ In support of the request, WBI states that it has filed a minor modification application to relocate the station to the STA site. WBI requests extension of STA to allow time for processing of its application.

We note that the previous STA expired on October 22, 2011. Our review indicates that the circumstances presented warrant grant of STA in order to provide for service to the public, and that the requested STA facilities are the same as were previously authorized. However, in light of the lapse of time between the expiration of the prior STA and the filing of the instant request, it will be considered as a request for a new STA; the authority granted will not cover the period between the expiration of the filing of the instant request.

Accordingly, the request for STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KXCS may operate with the following facilities:

Geographic coordinates:32° 20′ 03″ N, 101° 21′ 19″ W (NAD 1927)Channel288 (105.5 MHz)Effective radiated power:Not to exceed 2.0 kilowatts (H&V)Antenna height:77 metersabove ground:77 metersabove mean sea level:851 metersabove average terrain:100 meters

¹ KXCS is licensed for operation on Channel 288A (105.5 MHz) with effective radiated power of 5.1 kilowatts (H&V) and antenna height above average terrain of 109 meters.

WBI must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored. WBI must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. The authority granted herein does not cover the period between October 22, 2011, and January 13, 2012, and is without prejudice as to whatever action the Commission may take with respect to operation of Station KXCS during the foregoing period.

This authority expires on September 9, 2012.
