Request for Special Temporary Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Trent:

This letter concerns the request you filed on March 1, 2012, on behalf of 550 AM, Inc. ("550 AM"), for Special Temporary Authority to permit FM Translator Radio Station W239AP to remain silent.

550 AM's request states that Station W239AP went silent on December 1, 2011, due to the loss of its programming source. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.¹

550 AM's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station W239AP to remain silent not to exceed 180 days from the date of this letter. Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station W239AP will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m., December 2, 2012. See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 312(g).

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. Additionally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. *See* 47 C.F.R. §§ 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).

Finally, Section 73.1740(a)(4) of the Commission's Rules permits licensees to discontinue operations for good cause, and for a period not to exceed 30 days without further authority. See 47 C.F.R. §73.1740(a)(4). This rule requires that the licensee notify the Commission by letter "not later than the 10th day of limited or discontinued operations," and if operations are not able to commence by the 10th day, "informal written request shall be made to the FCC no later than the 30th day for such additional time as may be deemed necessary." 550 AM failed to submit a timely request for an STA to permit Station

W239AP to remain silent beyond January 1, 2012, and the action taken herein shall not be construed as authorizing the station to remain silent between January 1, 2012, and March 1, 2012.
