

Dear Mr. Miller:

On September 28, 2011, the Commission staff granted the above-referenced licensee's July 19, 2011 Request for Experimental Authorization, as supplemented on September 22, 2011. Tests were conducted pursuant to the Experimental Authorization and a report of the results of that testing was filed with the Commission on January 18, 2012. To the best of the licensee's knowledge, there were no complaints from the public as a result of the testing that was conducted.

It is respectfully requested that the Experimental Authorization be reinstated for a limited period of time. In this regard, the testing was done utilizing technology that was developed by Geo Broadcast Solutions, LLC (GBS). GBS is in the process of preparing a rulemaking to be submitted to the Commission seeking modification of the Commission's rules to permit program origination on boosters. Reinstatement is respectfully requested for a short period of time (i.e. seven (7) business days) to allow a further demonstration of the technology to equipment manufacturers. The testing would be identical to the testing that was previously conducted. If you have any questions with respect to this matter, please communicate with the undersigned.
