Dear Licensee:

This is with respect to the letter dated February 10, 2012, from the Video Services Division to Nancy Schrencongost, the licensee of Class A television station WLLS-LP, Indiana, Pennsylvania, regarding your apparent failure to make the required filing of quarterly FCC Form 398 (Children's Television Programming Report) for the station. A copy of the February 10, 2012 letter can be viewed in the station's correspondence folder in the Commission's Broadcast Radio & Television Electronic Filing System (CDBS) at http://licensing.fcc.gov/cgi-bin/prod/cdbforms/prod/getimportletter_exh.cgi?import_letter_id=31436.

Commission records indicate that the required Form 398 electronic filings for the station have not been made since the first quarter of 2005, and the February 10, 2012 letter required you to provide information, supported by the declaration of a person with personal knowledge, identifying the quarters in 2006, 2007, 2008, 2009 and 2010 for which reports were prepared and placed in the station's public file and the location of the public file. The letter further required that this information be filed within 30 days and stated that failure to provide the requested information or to notify the staff that you were electing to let station WLLS-LP revert to low power television status would result in the institution of a forfeiture proceeding and/or loss of Class A television status.

As of today, the Commission has not received a response to the Division's February 10, 2012 letter. Failure to provide the information required in the February 10 letter within 30 days from the date of this letter will result in a change of the station's status from Class A television to low power television status.
