Dear Mr. Johnson:

This is in reference to the above captioned minor change application to change the transmitter site for station WMHZ(AM), Holt, Alabama.

A preliminary review of the application reveals that the amended environmental showing is not acceptable. To be specific: (1) TTI's stated that it conducted a limited literature and records search, and that the site does not appear to be in a designated Wilderness Area or Wildlife preserve, so those conclusions must be verified; (2) TTI did not submit the USFWS response concerning threatened or endangered species; (3) Form 620 should not have been submitted in the amendment and therefore must be completely removed from the application in the next amendment, and replaced with evidence that TTI submitted Form 620 to the SHPO along with the SHPO response; and (4) TTI must provide the response from all tribes (only stated that tribes were contact via TCNS). As a result, an amendment must be filed to answer the questions mentioned above.

Further action on the subject application will be withheld for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of this letter to provide an opportunity to file a curative amendment. Failure to amend or respond within this time period will result in the dismissal of the application pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3568.
