Informal Objection

Dear Ms. Secretary:

KMCE, Inc. ("Petitioner"), by its attorney, for compelling reasons here notes its opposition to the grant of this license to cover. This facility, purporting to be a companion of an analog station licensed to and formerly serving Coalinga, California, by a series of daisy-chained movements has abandoned its original service area. The just previous location already had vacated the service area, and this was the a key basis of our Petition for Reconsideration of the grant of a license, BPDTV-20120130ALY, submitted on March 15, 2012. The objection applies with even greater force to this move. The underlying construction permit for "minor change" (BPDTL-20120213AAB) never should have been granted. Collectively these moves are a disguised major change. The application for license should be dismissed.

Unless and until our Petition directed against the previous grant of license is fully considered on the merits, there is no basis for the grant of this new license. If the Commission does grant the license application shown in the caption, it should condition the license to state that no further "minor" modification will be authorized.
