Dear Secretary Dortch:

This STA request is intiated due to a loss of the KWJP Transmission line. KWJP is a non-commercial station that is not subject to a STA filing fee. KWJP 89.7 FM Facility ID 171650 went on the air in July 2011. Since signing on we have experienced a number of outages due to transmitter failure. We were able to work with the Manufacturer BEI and replaced the transmitter control unit several times, but continued to have intermittent outages. Most of the outages were only a few seconds or the transmitter would change its set frequency. Finally the Reflective power started to increase drastically from a normal of 8- 10 to 300-400. At that time we turned off the transmitter and decided to look at the transmission line. We did find water in the line and immediately shut down the transmitter.

The transmission line was installed by a company out of St. Louis, who sent a crew to the tower sight to check out the line. The crew found several bolt holes in the line caused by faulty installation. We went silent on March 25 for the final time until we could secure a new transmission line and have it installed. The target date is April 5<sup>th</sup> or 6<sup>th</sup>. The transmission line has been ordered and should be in this week. We certainly look forward to getting back on the air as soon as possible. Thank you.
