## Dear Applicant:

By letters dated December 28, 2010, the staff dismissed the above-referenced applications for construction permits for new digital low power television stations at Santa Barbara because the proposed transmitter sites were located within 121 km of the reference coordinates of Los Angeles. CTB Spectrum Services Four LLC ("CTB") filed a timely petition for reconsideration, stating that it did not intend to specify a site within the prohibited area, and requesting reinstatement of its applications so that it can amend to propose compliant sites.

In view of the foregoing, the petitions for reconsideration filed by CTB ARE GRANTED and the above-referenced applications ARE REINSTATED. CTB is directed to amend to specify new sites within 30 days of the date of this letter.
