Dear Ms. Chargois:

This is in reference to the request filed March 13, 2012, on behalf of R & M Broadcasting Co. ("R&M"). R&M requests extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on July 22, 2011, to operate Station KJCB with temporary facilities.¹ In support of the request, R&M states that it continues to search for a new, permanent site for the station.

We note that the previous STA expired on January 22, 2012. Our review indicates that the circumstances presented warrant grant of STA in order to provide for service to the public, and that the requested STA facilities are the same as were previously authorized. However, in light of the lapse of time between the expiration of the prior STA and the filing of the instant request, it will be considered as a request for a new STA; the authority granted will not cover the period between the expiration of the prior STA and the filing of the instant request.

Accordingly, the request for STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KJCB may operate with the following facilities:

Geographic coordinates	30° 16' 07" N, 91° 55' 52" W (NAD 1927)
Frequency	770 KHz
Hours of operation	Unlimited
Operating power	Not to exceed 1 kW daytime, 0.125 kW nighttime
Antenna type	Long wire
Antenna efficiency	240 mV/m/km/kW
Overall height	6.1 meters (20 feet)

It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are

¹ KJCB is licensed for operation on 770 kHz with 1 kilowatt daytime and 0.5 kilowatt nighttime, employing a directional antenna during nighttime hours only (DA-N-U).

It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. R&M must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored.³ R&M must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. The authority granted herein does not cover the period between January 22, 2012, and March 13, 2012, and is without prejudice as to whatever action the Commission may take with respect to operation of Station KJCB during the foregoing period.

This authority expires on **November 16, 2012**.
