Dear Mr. Johnson:

This is in reference to: the above captioned minor change application to modify Construction Permit BNP-20080307ACZ by changing the site and tower height for the new unbuilt facility for WMHZ(AM), Holt, Alabama; our April 6, 2012, deficiency letter requesting an environmental amendment within 30 days; and the May 3, 2012, request for an additional 60 days to amend.

A preliminary review of the application reveals that the underlying permit expires on October 28, 2012, therefore we advise that a curative amendment to resolve all problems be filed as soon as possible to allow our staff time to review and grant if found to be acceptable, leaving enough time to fully construct and file a fully completed FCC Form 302 license application.

Accordingly, the request is hereby granted, and further action on the subject application will be withheld for a period of sixty (60) days from the date of this letter to provide an opportunity to file a curative amendment. Failure to amend or respond within this time period will result in the dismissal of the application pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3568.
