Dear Mr. Smithwick:

This letter is in reference to the above-captioned minor change application to change the daytime pattern and add a new critical hours pattern for station WXJO(AM), and the November 8, 2011, amendment.

A preliminary review of the amended application reveals that the FCC's Enforcement Bureau (EB) staff has objected to the proposed daytime operation because the proposal would put a field strength of 13.9 mV/m exceeding the maximum allowed limit of 10 mV/m towards the FCC's Powder Springs Georgia Monitoring Station. As a result, EB's staff has requested that the application be amended to change the proposal (by reducing power, changing site, etc...) in order to meet the 10 mV/m limit.

Further action on the subject application will be withheld for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of this letter to provide an opportunity to file a curative electronic amendment. Failure to amend or respond within this time period will result in the dismissal of the application pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3568(a).
