Dear Licensee:

By letters dated August 6, 2010, the Video Division dismissed the above-referenced applications for digital flash-cut construction permits for stations K41FM, Deming, New Mexico and K20AH, Caballo, New Mexico because the Mexican Department of Communications informed the Commission that it would object to grant of the proposed facilities because they did not comply with certain distance requirements with respect to channel allotments in Mexico. KOB-TV, LLC, the licensee of the stations, filed a timely petition for reconsideration and on May 11, 2012, supplemented the petitions to provide further technical information demonstrating that the proposed facilities would not cause interference to the Mexican allotments.

In view of the foregoing, the petitions for reconsideration ARE GRANTED and the above-referenced applications ARE REINSTATED for further international coordination.
