Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed October 30, 2008¹, on behalf of Urban Radio II, LLC ("UR2"). UR2 requests further extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") originally granted on December 20, 1999, and modified on February 19, 2004, to duplicate the programming of Station WJNT (AM) on FM Booster WJNT-FM1 to overcome Cuban interference. In support of the request, UR2 states that the interference continues.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WJNT-FM1 may continue to operate, nighttime hours only², with the following facilities:

Effective radiated power	0.5 kilowatt (H&V)

¹ Processing of the request was delayed due to the use of an incorrect form. A request for operation with technical facilities at variance from licensed facilities, such as the instant request, is an "engineering" STA, as opposed to a "legal" STA. The "legal" category is reserved for operation with deleted facilities, main studio waiver requests, and other non-technical matters.

UR2 must take whatever steps are necessary to prevent exposure of workers and/or the public to radio frequency fields in excess of the Commission's exposure limits. *See* 47 CFR Sections 1.1307(b), 1.1310. This authority will terminate upon discontinuation of excessive power operation by Cuban Station CMGL. This authority is subject to modification or cancellation by the FCC without prior notice or right to hearing. *See* 47 CFR Section 73.1635(b).

This authority expires on **December 8, 2012**.
