Dear Mr. Fuss:

This is in reference to the request filed May 29, 2012, on behalf of Delta Radio Network, LLC ("DRN"). DRN requests extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on December 27, 2011, to operate Station WNIX with emergency antenna facilities pursuant to Section 73.1680.¹ In support of the request, DRN states that it has been granted a construction permit to operate nondirectionally during nighttime hours; however, the necessary modifications to the antenna system have not yet been completed.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has made substantial progress toward restoring licensed operation. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WNIX may continue to operate during nighttime hours with an emergency nondirectional antenna and

¹ WNIX is licensed for operation on 1330 kHz with 1 kilowatt daytime and 0.5 kilowatt nighttime, employing a directional antenna during nighttime hours only (DA-N-U). Construction Permit BP-20120119ABY authorizes a reduction in nighttime power to 0.055 kilowatt, nondirectional (ND-2-U).

reduced power not to exceed 0.125 kilowatt. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. DRN must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **December 7, 2012**.
