Dear Mr. McVicar:

This is in reference to the request filed June 20, 2012, on behalf of WQDY, Inc. ("WI"). WI requests extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on December 23, 2011, to operate Station WCRQ with reduced power.¹ In support of the request, WI states that it is waiting for the return of its antenna from the manufacturer.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has been prevented from restoring licensed operation due to causes beyond its control and has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WCRQ may continue to operate with reduced power. WI must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored. WI must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the

¹ WCRQ is licensed for operation on Channel 275C1 (102.9 MHz) with effective radiated power of 100 kilowatts (H&V) and antenna height above average terrain of 139 meters.

public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **December 26, 2012**.
