KTWO(AM), Casper, WY, Facility No. 11924**


On behalf Townsquare Media Casper License, LLC, the licensee of AM broadcast station KTWO, this is to request a waiver, pursuant to the procedures set forth in September 13, 2011 Public Notice DA 11-1535, of Section 73.1560(a) of the Commission's rules to permit the station to utilize Modulation Dependent Carrier Level ("MDCL") control technologies.

KTWO is currently operating in normal modulation without hybrid digital mode. With MDCL operation, the station's signal will continue comply with spectral emissions mask requirements in Section 73.44 of the Commission's rules. The KTWO transmitter will achieve full licensed power at +10dbm, or when the MDCL is temporarily disabled.

The transmitter for KTWO is proposed to utilize Harris AMC MDCL modulation kit HARDXLPAMC-ACCFLD as installed by a factory technician. The station will retain the ability to bypass to normal modulation for power and field readings, as needed.

An executed Anti-Drug Abuse Certification is attached. Please let me know if you need any additional information or have any questions.


