Special Temporary Authorization

Dear Mr. Mueller:

This is in reference to the request filed July 17, 2012, on behalf of Renda Broadcasting Corporation of Nevada ("RBCN"). RBCN requests extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on January 17, 2012, to operate Station KOKC with reduced power, due to component failure in its transmitter. In support of the request, RBCN states that initial efforts to repair the transmitter were unsuccessful, and that a new transmitter has been ordered. RBCN states that its estimated timeframe for installation of the new transmitter is 60 days.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has made progress toward restoration of licensed operation, but additional time is required for completing the work. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KOKC may continue to operate with reduced power. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. RBCN must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored.² RBCN must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers

and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR \S 1.1310.

This authority expires on November 7, 2012.
