Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed August 8, 2012, on behalf of San Joaquin Broadcasting Co., Non-Profit Corporation ("SJB"). SJB requests special field test authority ("SFTA") pursuant to Section 73.1515. In support of the request, SJB states that it plans to conduct field strength measurements in order to test the viability of an alternative transmitter site. SJB proposes to operate on its currently licensed channel for a brief period of four to six hours on August 23 and 24, 2012.

Our review indicates that the proposed operation would result in extension of the 60 dBu contour beyond the licensed contour toward the northwest; however, given the brief nature and timing of the proposed test operation, we believe that the Public Interest would be served by grant of the requested SFTA.

Accordingly, the request for SFTA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KLVS may operate with the following facilities:

¹ KLVS is licensed to Stockton, California, for operation on Channel 297B (107.3 MHz) with effective radiated power of 8.1 kilowatts (H only) and antenna height above average terrain of 491 meters. Construction Permit BPED-20100915ABK authorizes a change in the community of license to Livermore.

Operation of the licensed KLVS transmitter shall be discontinued whenever the test transmitter is in operation. Test transmissions shall consist of unmodulated carrier plus hourly station identification, except that audio tones or music may be broadcast if required in order to positively identify the test transmitter from the measurment location, in which case waiver of Section 73.1515(c)(2) is granted to the extent indicated. SJB must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310. Within 60 days following conclusion of the test operation, a report of the results obtained shall be submitted pursuant to Section 73.1515(c)(7).

This authority expires on August 25, 2012.
