
Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of GH Broadcasting, Inc. ("GH") and pursuant to Section 73.6001(d) of the Commission's rules, this is a request to change the status of KXPX-CA, Corpus Christi, TX, from Class A to Low Power Television Station. GH has determined that KXPX-CA is unable to meet the minimum operating requirements for Class A television stations. Therefore, GH seeks to retain the license for KXPX-CA but to revert to low power television status.

Currently pending before the Commission are the Station's renewal application (File No. BRTTA-20060403APP) and an application to assign the license for the Station to KXPX License Company, LLC BALTTA-20120315ADZ. GH respectfully requests that the Commission has reclassified KXPX-CA, it will move forward with grant of the renewal and assignment applications.
