On behalf of the Town of Monroe, Connecticut, licensee of FM translator station W220CE, Southington, Connecticut, and pursuant to Section 74.1263(c) of the Rules, we herewith notify the Commission that on September 8, 2012, the licensee discovered that the translator station had ceased operations as a result of transmitter failure.
