Dear Licensee:

This is with respect to the letter dated April 10, 2012 from the Video Services Division to Paging Associates, Inc. ("Paging"), the licensee of Class A television station W28AJ, Allington, Connecticut, regarding its apparent failure to make the required filing of quarterly FCC Form 398 (Children's Television Programming Report) for the station. Commission records indicate that the required Form 398 electronic filings for the station have not been made since the first quarter of 2010, and the April 10, 2012 letter required Paging to provide information, supported by the declaration of a person with personal knowledge, identifying the quarters in 2010 and 2011 for which reports were prepared and placed in the station's public file and the location of the public file. The letter further required that this information be filed within 30 days and stated that failure to provide the requested information or to notify the staff that Paging was electing to let station W28AJ revert to low power television status would result in the institution of a forfeiture proceeding and/or loss of Class A television status.

As of today, the Commission has not received a response to the Division's April 10, 2012 letter. Failure to provide the information required in the April 10 letter within 30 days from the date of this letter will result in a change of the station's status from Class A television to low power television status.
