Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed September 26, 2012, on behalf of Grundy County Broadcasters, Inc. ("GCB"). GCB requests extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on March 28, 2012, to operate Station WCSJ-FM with reduced power.¹ In support of the request, GCB states that improvements to the station's transmitting equipment are under way, including replacement of the antenna and transmitter. GCB states that continued operation with reduced power is necessary to allow time for completion of the work.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has made progress toward restoration of licensed operation, but additional time is required for completing the work. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WCSJ-FM

¹ WCSJ-FM is licensed for operation on Channel 276A (103.1 MHz) with effective radiated power of 6 kilowatts (Max-DA, H&V) and antenna height above average terrain of 100 meters.

may continue to operate with reduced power. GCB must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored. GCB must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **May 2, 2013**.
