Dear Applicant:

By letter dated September 17, 2012, the above-referenced applications for new digital construction permits were dismissed because the proposed facilities did not comply with the geographic restrictions adopted by the Commission in connection with its announcement that it would permit the filing of new digital-only LPTV and TV translator stations in rural areas. Landover 2 LLC filed a timely petition for reconsideration, proffering an amendment in an attempt to correct these deficiencies.

In view of the foregoing, and our engineering analysis taking into account the amendments for all four facilities referenced above the geographic restriction issues have been resolved and the petition for reconsideration IS GRANTED and the application have been processed for Grant and will appear on the next proposed grant list.
