Dear Applicant:

This refers to your attorney's letter dated November 15, 2012, for special temporary authority (STA) to operate at reduced effective radiated power (ERP). You indicate that the construction of CP (BMPCDT-20120629ADM), granted is underway. However, because the complete transmitter will not be delivered and installed until the second quarter of 2013; and the licensee has a smaller transmitter immediately available, the licensee requests that the Commission grant the proposed STA to operate in the interim.

You state that reduced power operations will continue to be necessary while the applicant is trying to complete the construction and restore full power operation.

In light of the above, special temporary authority pursuant to Sections 73.1560(d) and 73.1635 of the Commission's Rules until May 20, 2013 IS GRANTED.

We wish to point out that an extension of this request must include detailed reasons and a description of efforts being taken to return the station to full power operation.
