Dear Applicant:

This refers to your attorney's letter dated November 29, 2012, for special temporary authority (STA) to operate at reduced effective radiated power (ERP). You indicate that power amplifier modules in the transmitter failed and were determined to be nonoperational. You mentioned that this situation occurred in conjunction with the failure of multiple loads in the transmitter power amplifier cabin, causing the station to be unable to operate at full power. You state that reduced power operations will continue to be necessary while the applicant is trying to complete the repairs and restore full power operation.

In light of the above, special temporary authority pursuant to Sections 73.1560(d) and 73.1635 of the Commission's Rules until June 3, 2013 IS GRANTED.

We wish to point out that an extension of this request must include detailed reasons and a description of efforts being taken to return the station to full power operation.
