Dear Mr. Agosto:

This is in reference to your request filed December 3, 2012, on behalf of Centro Colegial Cristiano, Inc. ("CCC"). CCC requests extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on May 31, 2012, to operate Station WVID with reduced power. CCC states that it received repair parts for its transmitter (which is no longer manufactured), but has determined that the transmitter tube, and perhaps other parts, must also be replaced.²

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond
 the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve
 the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has made progress toward restoration of licensed operation, but additional time is required for completing the work. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.

¹ WVID is licensed for operation on Channel 212B (90.3 MHz) with effective radiated power of 14.5 kilowatts (H&V) and antenna height above average terrain of 304 meters.

² WVID has filed requests for reduced power operation intermittently since December 2007.

Given the difficulty of finding working parts, and the ongoing repair problems, we will (for this time only) grant an STA for reduced power operation for a period of six months instead of the usual 90 days. We expect that this period will be sufficient for all transmitter repairs or replacement, and that no further extensions of this authority will be necessary.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WVID may operate with reduced power. **CCC must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored**. CCC must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on June 10, 2013.
